1. PURPOSE

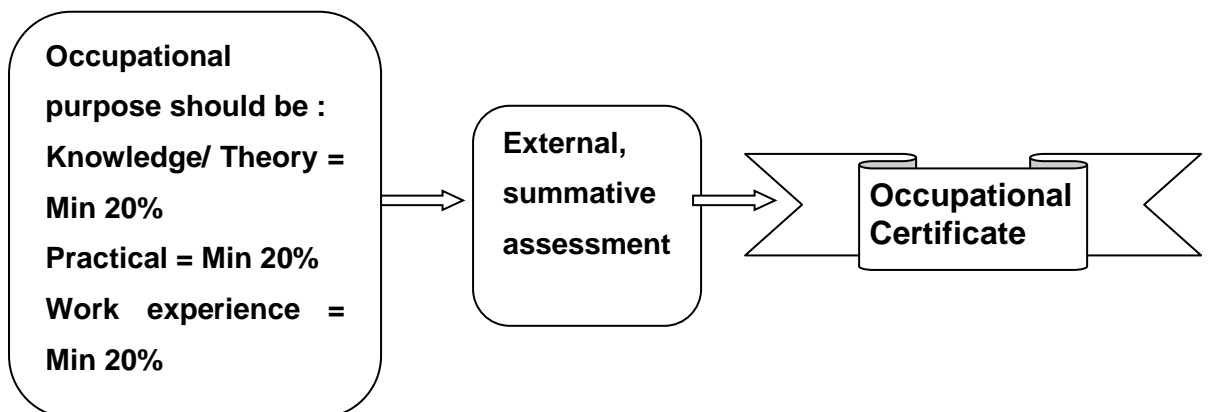
The purpose to give brief report on the outcome of the re-aligning and developing of an Occupational Qualification for the Disaster Management Officer (OFO Code: 541907) and Disaster Management Manager (OFO Code: 134912) by Local Government Sector Education and Training Authority (LGSETA).

2. BACKGROUND

The Local Government Sector Education and Training Authority (LGSETA) is in the process of re-aligning and developing of an Occupational Qualification for the Disaster Management Officer (OFO Code: 541907) and Disaster Management Manager (OFO Code: 134912) .

Occupational Qualification means a qualification associated with **a trade, occupation or profession** resulting from **work-based learning** and consisting of **knowledge, practical and work experience**

Occupational qualification and curriculum



The purpose is to re-align FETC: Generic Management: Disaster Risk Management NQF 4 into Disaster Management Officer (OFO Code: 541907) and Disaster Management Manager (OFO Code: 134912).

The process of re-align and develop for the industry is done through the following steps:

- Application - request submission to develop an occupational qualification
- Appointment of Development Quality Partner (DQP)
- Appointment of Qualification Development Facilitator (QDF)
- Community of Expert Practitioners (CEP's) and
- Assessment quality Partner (AQP)

Curriculum Document

Curriculum document is based on an occupational profile derived from the occupational purpose and the associated occupational tasks or outcomes.
